Training on "Security and Secure Coding"

Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Bhilai in collaboration with CDAC Noida recently organized a two-day training on "Security and Secure Coding" on August 28-29, 2021. The training was part of the project entitled "Building Trust on Computing Platform and Training of Secure Coding of Security Chips" funded by MeitY (Govt. of India) under the "Skill India" initiative. It was organized to introduce security in general and promote the best coding standards and practices prevailing in the market. The event saw a cumulative participation of over 250 online attendees, with prominent speakers from academia, industry, and government organizations.
